

THE SHIP'S COMPANY

Membership in the Ship's Company is by the annual invitation of the Michigan Maritime Museum. Continued membership is at the sole discretion of the Michigan Maritime Museum. While all individual members of the Ship's Company must continually meet the conditions set forth in the manual, no continued rights to participate as a member of the Ship's Company accrue to any member for any reason, such as, by way of example and not limitation, skill, seniority or other contribution.

Conditions for Inclusion in the Ship's Company:

All members of the Ship's Company will:

- Be members of the Michigan Maritime Museum
- Register by providing e-mail addresses at work and home, telephone numbers and other information that will facilitate short notice communications.
- Devote at a minimum, one weekend in the spring to assist with rigging, one weekend in the fall to assist with de-rigging and winter preparation and time as may be necessary to maintain the vessel.
- If a member desires to crew upon the vessel, s/he will complete what training is offered from time to time to render them competent in whatever position they serve. Such training may entail lessons in sailing, basic seamanship, safety, first-aid, navigation, etc. Training will be offered by the Michigan Maritime Museum but may also be obtained from other organizations such as, by way of example, the US Coast Guard Auxiliary and the US Power Squadron.
- Assist in interpreting *Friends Good Will* to the public or persons or organizations who charter the vessel or make arrangements to visit. Educational interpretation may, from time to time, entail reenacting history in period uniforms or dress as established by the Michigan Maritime Museum and supplied and paid for by each individual member of the Ship's Company as appropriate for the position served on-board as crew, if any.
- Adhere to the rules, regulations, and policies as established by the Michigan Maritime Museum, the provisions of the Policy and Training Manual and will at all times conduct themselves appropriately and so as to reflect positively upon the Michigan Maritime Museum. Violations of these principles referenced above may result in exclusion from the Ship's Company.

Affiliation With and Support of Sea Scout Ship No. 5191

The Ship's Company will also include, irrespective of individual membership in the Michigan Maritime Museum, then current members in good standing of the Sea Scout Ship No. 5191. Sea Scout members will in all other respects, other than membership in the Michigan Maritime Museum, adhere to and fulfill all policies and conditions set forth in the Policy and Training Manual. Various positions aboard *Friends Good Will* are available to be filled by members of the Sea Scouts, as recommended to and appointed by the Captain(s).
